

## **RDAQ Privacy Policy**

RDAQ is committed to your privacy. The following discloses our information gathering and distribution processes.

Our conference registration site will collect Information necessary for your attendance at the Conference. A participant list with name, organisation, state/territory, and email address, will be supplied to third party (sponsors). Registrants will be asked to opt out of this via an option during the registration process.

Further, notwithstanding any opt out of promotional information by the user, we reserve the right to contact a subscriber regarding account status, changes to the registration details or event details and other relevant matters.

We do reserve the right to perform statistical analyses of user behaviour and characteristics in order to measure interest in and use of the various areas of the site and to inform sponsors of such information as well as the number of users that have been exposed to or clicked on their advertising banners.

Upon request, we will allow any user to "opt out" of further promotional contacts at any time through our marketing software.

Additionally, upon request, we will use reasonable efforts to allow users to update/correct personal information previously submitted which the user states is erroneous to the extent such activities will not compromise privacy or security interests. Also, upon a user's request, we will use commercially reasonable efforts to functionally delete the user and his or her personal information from our database; however, it may be impossible to delete a user's entry without some residual information because of backups and records of deletions.

Access to the database containing personal information is restricted to Rural Doctors Association and conference team members. Authorised staff members are not allowed to pass on information about members to non-authorised staff without the express permission of the General Manager.
